

18.30.080: SPECIAL PROVISIONS:

B. Slope Protection: All land surface having a slope of thirty percent (30%) or greater shall remain in its natural state and shall not be graded or otherwise disturbed except for the planting of additional vegetation, the addition of sprinkler irrigation systems, the establishment of required fire breaks or required access easements, or when such disturbance is specifically provided for under an approved site plan. No disturbance shall be permitted on any slide area as depicted in the Utah County natural hazards overlay landslide zones map until recommended by the city engineer based on adequate documentation to show that sliding is not a potential hazard and then only after approval is gained through the city council.
