

## [Chapter 15.04 SUBDIVISIONS](#)

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### **Section 15.04.620 Iron castings.**

All iron casting shall conform to the requirements of ASTM Designation A-48 (Class 30) for grey iron castings.

Rings and covers shall be equal to the thirty (30) inch standard with machined bearing surfaces and with cover weight of one hundred fifty (150) pounds and ring weight of two hundred thirty-three (233) pounds. Each cover shall contain one pick hole and no air vent holes. In addition to the foundry name and year of manufacture, the cover shall be marked "Storm Drain".

All manhole rings shall be carefully set to the grade shown on the drawings or as directed by the Davis County Flood Control Engineer. (Ord. 5-1988 § 1 (part): Development Code 4-4-4)
