

3-19: LOCATION OF BUILDINGS AND PENS CONTAINING FARM ANIMALS

A. No building, feed yard, corral, pen, or coop used for farm animals (specifically domestic livestock, poultry, or mink or other fur bearers) shall be constructed closer than fifty (50) feet to an existing dwelling or vice versa.

B. No such building, feed yard, corral, pen, or coop shall be constructed or maintained closer than twenty (20) feet to any open waterway that drains into a natural stream. Surface drainage from corrals, pens, or coops shall not be permitted to drain into a waterway that drains, either directly or indirectly, into a natural stream or lake.
