

3-37: ADVERTISING AND OTHER SIGNS

B. FREEWAY SIGNS

In addition to other types of signs which may be qualified for placement in the zone, the Zoning Administrator may issue a permit for a community sign in the RA-5, M&G-1 or the A-40 Zones when all of the following requirements are met:

1. If the sign identifies an incorporated city or town of Utah County for the convenience of the traveling public.
2. No more than two signs in Utah County are permitted for any city or town.
3. The sign is alongside of and clearly visible from a travel lane of an interstate road.
4. A permit for the sign is obtained from the Utah State Department of Transportation.
5. No advertising or businesses are mentioned on the sign.
6. The face of the sign does not exceed eight-hundred square feet in area, and the highest point on the sign and structure is no more than twenty (20) feet above the nearest traveled surface of the road.
