

10-21-1: PURPOSE:

A. The purpose of this chapter is to address planning issues and aesthetic concerns brought on by the demand for wireless communication facilities.

B. The regulations contained herein are intended to minimize the visual impact of wireless communication facilities while providing for service throughout the county. The regulations are further intended to require colocation of facilities and set forth clear and objective criteria.

C. The requirements of this chapter apply to low power radio services, both analog and digital, such as "cellular" and "PCS" (personal communications system) communications and paging system. All facilities shall comply with the following regulations and all other ordinances of the county and any pertinent regulations of the federal communications commission and the federal aviation administration. The regulations contained herein are pursuant to the telecommunications act of 1996. (Ord. 2001-815-O, 12-17-2001, eff. 12-17-2001)
